

Introduction

The Millbrook Inn is situated in the heart of the village of South Pool deep in the South Hams countryside.

- We are open every day of the year from 12 noon to 11.30pm.
- Lunch is served every day from 12 noon to 5 pm (with roast on Sundays until 3 pm)
- Supper is served from 7 pm to 9 pm
- The pub is located on a road with a drop off to level access to the pub.
- The pub is accessible by wheel chair.

Pre-Arrival

- The nearest railway station is Totnes which is approximately 19.3 miles away. The nearest bus service is at Frogmore which is 1.8 miles away.

Car Parking and Arrival

- Car parking is on the road outside the pub. There are no disabled parking spaces.
- The road is level and surfaced with tarmac.
- There are no street lights.
- The main entrance to the pub slopes down slightly from the road. The front door opens outwards and has a clear width of 800mm.
- Our staff are on hand throughout opening hours to assist customers.
- The Millbrook Inn is a tiny pub but it is possible to access the bar and dining areas via the front entrance.
- There is adequate space between some tables for either wheelchair or pushchair users.
- The pub is furnished with tables and chairs of various styles. We have a mixture of fixed bench seating and upright chairs, some with arms and some without. The clear height under the tables ranges from 600mm to 750mm.
- The pub is illuminated with a mixture of traditional style light fittings all using low energy led bulbs.
- Candles are used throughout the pub in the evenings and during the winter months.
- There is no background music, no television screens and no gaming machines.

- The floor surface throughout the ground floor is slate, wood or concrete. There are no carpets but we do have loose rugs in the main bar area.
- The pub is heated by an open fireplaces and a woodburner.
- If you have any food or drink allergies or intolerances, please speak to a member of our team before placing your order. Our kitchen uses ingredients that may contain the 14 notifiable allergens – cereals containing gluten, crustaceans, eggs, fish, peanuts, soya beans, milk, nuts, celery, sesame, sulphites, lupin and molluscs.
Data sheets listing the ingredients of the products we make and serve are available at the bar. Please ask a member of our team if you would like to see this. Special dietary needs can be catered for on request.
- Menus are available in printed form, enlarged copies by request and specials are displayed on a blackboard. Our team are trained to read out menus/prices lists.
- Our crockery is predominantly white and our tables are wooden so a contrast is visible.
- Drink service is from the bar although we are happy to assist by taking an order from your table - please ask.
- Customer Toilets - our Gentleman's (610mm wide) and Ladies public toilets (640mm wide) can be found on the ground floor. At present they are not wheel chair accessible.

Beer Garden/Outdoor Area/Smoking area

- There is an outside paved courtyard to the side of the pub which is accessible to all.
- There is a seating area to the rear of the pub and a stream which is accessible for children. This area is not accessible to wheel chair users.
- Food and drink can be served at any of the outside tables from the pub and table service is available.

Additional Information

- All of our staff receive regular training including disability awareness training.
- We welcome assistance dogs throughout the building. A water bowl is available outside the front door.
- In the event of an evacuation our staff are trained to assist and provide safe exits from the building.
